

G&D Help Improve Spen Valley Parks

Huddersfield specialist fabricators G&D Enterprises have completed two projects that have helped improve the look of local authority parks in Heckmondwike and Cleckheaton.

Parkland in the centre of Heckmondwike was earmarked for improvement in the run-up to Christmas, when Kirklees council wanted to surround the land with new decorative panelling, interspersed with tall, gently curved illumination that would create a 'crown of lights'.

G&D Enterprises, who work with various departments of the council, secured the contract, then worked with the outline designs, modifying them

to create a stunning and contemporary centrepiece for the town in time for the Christmas festivities. The firm completed the project in an amazing four weeks, from manufacture to installation.

In nearby Cleckheaton, the council wanted to install new, but very traditional, boundary railings around the town's most popular park. Again, G&D Enterprises interpreted the original designs, but suggested some modifications which would strengthen the railings and improve the finished look. The project involved 330 linear metres of railings and the end result has attracted nothing but favourable comments from local residents and visitors.
